

THE MALTA TOUR COLLECTION

Full Day Prehistoric Temples Tour - 0900hrs

Departure from hotel in coach accompanied by guide and we transfer to the south to visit Hagar Qim Temple which is unique among the Maltese temples because globigerina lime- stone was used throughout its construction. There are complicated decorations carved on some of the stones and an oracular chamber and altars. Just a short distance away, we will be able to see the Mnajdra Temple which is a short walk down the hill from Hagar Qim.

We proceed our tour to Wied iz-Zurrieq where we visit the Blue Grotto and other grottos from close by on typical small Maltese traditional Luzzus - weather permitting. (Boat price not included)

In the afternoon, we will visit Ghar Dalam Cave which is a highly important site as it was here that the earliest evidence of human settlement on Malta, some 7,400 years ago, was discovered. What makes the site even more fascinating is that it was in use during World War II, when it served first as an air raid shelter and later as a fuel storage depot.

- Heavy restoration programmes on temples is underway, should temples mentioned above not be available, other temples of same importance will be considered.
