

# THE MALTA TOUR COLLECTION

## Full Day The Two Cities - 0900hrs

Departure from hotel in coach accompanied by guide to Valletta - The Capital city of Malta, the City built by the knights of St John. During our walking tour of the city, we will first visit the Upper Bar- racca Gardens which have a fantastic view of the Grand Harbour and the Three Historical Cities. We then visit St John's Co Cathedral which is historically and artistically one of the most important monuments on the island. This cathedral is adorned in riches that date back to the Knights of Malta including the world famous Caravaggio painting that is on display in the Oratory of this Cathedral. Finally, we visit the Grand Master' Palace which has two lovely courtyards and the state rooms. Lastly, we stop at the Malta Experience, a multivision show that depicts Malta's history throughout the ages.

In the afternoon, we will take it a bit easier and visit the former Capital city of Malta - Mdina (also called Citta Notabile). It is a medieval town, with narrow quiet streets situated in the centre of the island. It is also know as the "Silent City". It commands a magnificent view of the Island. Evidence for settlement in Mdina Goes back to over 4000 BC. Today, no cars (other than those of a limited number of residents and horse drawn carriages) are allowed in Mdina and there is a calming atmosphere as one walks along its narrow streets and ways. The city displays an unusual mix of Norman and Baroque architecture, including several palaces, most of which serve as private homes.
